Looks like Shaun White will be hanging out with a select group of skaters in the Cayman Islands next month. No, not on vacation they are working. Yeah, working. Why there? Apparently one of the world's largest skateparks, Black Pearl Skate is there and they are hosting summer camps this year. Time to hit your parents up about going to camp where pros like White, Bucky Lasek and Rune Gilberg will all be hanging out.

All you need is \$280 for five days. Oh yeah, then there's the plane ticket and the hotel. But kids flying on Cayman Airways out of Miami, Tampa, and JFK in New York are in luck because travelers 11 years old and younger fly free June 1st through September 7th. Minimum age for campers is 4 (kids 4-6 must be accompanied by parent), maximum age is 17.
